Did you know?

- 1) One child will use 6000 disposable diapers from birth to potty training, which equals one ton of garbage. Using washable diapers will reduce the quantity of waste sent to landfill.
- 2) Disposable diapers take years to decompose.
- 3) Thousands of trees per year are cut down in Canada to make disposable diapers.
- 4) Savings of approximately \$ 1,500 per child.

Eligibility (see more details at russell.ca):

- 1) From January 1, 2020, must have a child of less than 6 months old or be pregnant;
- 2) Be a resident of Russell Township;
- 3) Use washable diapers from birth to potty training;
- 4) Sign up before December 31st, 2020;
- 5) Submit documentation in the first six months after the birth;
- 6) Purchase a minimum of 20 new washable diapers during 2020.

Documentation required

- 1) Proof of residence (e.g. driver's licence, lease, hydro bill, etc.);
- 2) Original invoice for the purchase of a minimum of twenty (20) washable diapers;
- 3) Proof of birth of the child (birth certificate). If you are pregnant, you may submit this at a later date.
