

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSELL

By-law #2018-169

Being a by-law to provide for Councillors to be appointed
Acting Mayor for the term of office of the present Council.

WHEREAS Section 242 of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25* and amendments thereto, provides that Council may by by-law appoint a member of the council, to act from time to time, in the place of the head of Council, when the head of Council is absent from the municipality or refuses to act or the office is vacant; and


WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Township of Russell deems it advisable to appoint such member of Council who shall be known at such time as the Acting Mayor, and while so acting, shall have all the powers and duties of the head of Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSELL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** members of Council of the Corporation of the Township of Russell be and are hereby appointed to act, from time to time, in the place of the Head of Council when the head of Council is absent or refuses to act or the office is vacant as follows:
 - (a) December 1 to December 31 in the year 2018: Jamie Laurin;
 - (b) First quarter (January 1 to March 31) in the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022: Jamie Laurin;
 - (c) Second quarter (April 1 to June 30) in the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022: André Brisson;
 - (d) Third quarter (July 1 to September 30) in the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022: Cindy Saucier; and
 - (e) Fourth quarter - (October 1 to December 31) in the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and (October 1 to November 14) in the year 2022: Mike Tarnowski;
2. **THAT** in the absence of both the Mayor and the appointed Acting Mayor, the next member of council in the order set out above, shall act during such absence in the place and stead of the Mayor;
3. **THAT** while so acting, the said members shall have all the rights, powers and duties of the head of Council;
4. **THAT** By-law Number 2018-071, being a by-law to appoint an Acting Mayor for the remainder of the term of office of the previous Council, previously approved on June 4, 2018, be and the same are hereby repealed.
5. **THAT** this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon final reading thereof.
