

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSELL

By-law # 2020-015

Being a by-law to establish honorariums for non-elected members of committees and local boards.

WHEREAS Section 283 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 and its amendments, provides that the Council may establish by by-law the remuneration and expenses of the members of any local board of the municipality for attendance at Committee meetings of Council and that such remuneration and expenses may be determined in any manner that Council considers advisable; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Russell did enact By-law No. 2016-121, on November 7th, 2016, being a By-law to establish honorariums for non-elected members of committees and local boards; and

WHEREAS at its January 13th, 2020 Regular Council meeting, Council discussed potential revisions to the existing Honorariums for non-elected members of committees and local boards By-law 2016-121 as amended;

RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSELL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That an honorarium of \$106.00 per meeting shall be paid to:
 - a. All members of the Accessibility Advisory Committee who are not employees or elected members of the Corporation of the Township of Russell.
 - b. All members of the Planning Advisory Committee and Committee of Adjustment who are not employees or elected members of the Corporation of the Township of Russell. If both meetings take place on the same day, then only one (1) honorarium per meeting shall be paid instead of two (2).
 - c. All members of the Line Fence Viewers who are not employees of the Corporation of the Township of Russell.
 - d. All members of the Property Standards Committee who are not employees of the Corporation of the Township of Russell.

2. That voluntary committee members (committee members not receiving remuneration as prescribed in section 1.), be provided with a yearly pass for the Walking/Running Track or equivalent credit on a higher valued pass at the Russell Sports Dome. Committee Members sitting on a voluntary basis on multiple committees are only eligible to receive one (1) yearly pass. Members sitting on multiple committees, where the member is paid on a committee and is not on any others, such member will not be provided with a yearly pass or equivalent credit at the Russell Sports Dome.
3. That By-law 2016-121, being a by-law establishing honorariums for non-elected members of committees and local boards, previously adopted on November 7, 2016 and its amendment, By-law 2016-133, previously adopted on November 21, 2016, be and the same are hereby repealed.
4. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon final reading thereof.
